BUILD CAMBODIA - ESTIMATED PARTICIPANT COSTS

Included in Trip Costs

(divided equally among participants)

- Visa fees for entry into Cambodia
- Lodging costs
- Group breakfast, lunches and dinners
- All ground transportation using air conditioned vehicles
- Interpreter
- Official trip photographer and videographer, including CDs of photos and DVD of footage once trip is completed
- SOS International medical insurance
- All entry fees at temples, museums and monuments on group sight seeing/cultural excursions
- Tips/gratuuity to local staff (in hotels, hired guides, etc.)

Not included in Trip Costs

(individual participant's responsibility)

- Passport Costs
- International airfare to/from Cambodia
- Lodging costs while in transit to/from Cambodia
- International airport departure taxes
- When necessary, cost of visas outside of Cambodia (see "Visa" below)
- Items of a personal nature, such as private meals outside of the group, shopping, etc.
- Hotel incidentals, such as laundry, room service, Internet, etc.
- Telephone charges from hotel or staff cell phones
- Trip cancellation, travel delay or baggage insurance

Additional Participant Information

Participant Insurance

(included in Participant Trip Costs)

Build Cambodia requires all participants to purchase travel insurance through International SOS. International SOS is the world's leading provider of medical assistance, international healthcare, security services and outsourced customer care. They offer immediate medical assistance while you're overseas, and in Cambodia, they are based in Phnom Penh, with an international call center in Bangkok. They are available 24-hours a day, 7-days a week, and offer insurance and a global "911" service including emergency evacuation and repatriation for members.

The fee for one-time trip insurance is \$110 per person. This is valid for up to 17 days in a country. This \$110 cost has already been built into your participant trip costs. However, SOS also offers an annual frequent traveler membership plan which covers members for one year, with each trip not to exceed 90 days. The rate for the annual frequent traveler membership is \$325.

Build Cambodia staff will facilitate the purchase of SOS insurance for each participant. We will purchase one-time trip insurance for each participant. If you would like to upgrade to the annual frequent traveler membership plan, please inform Build Cambodia staff and we will adjust the status of your insurance application.

Passport

All participants must have a valid passport for travel to Cambodia. Passports must not be within 6 months of their expiration date and you must have two blank pages next to each other within the passport for your Cambodian visa.

Visa

All participants will receive their Cambodian visa at the airport upon entry into the country. The \$25 visa fee has been included in participant trip costs. All participants must bring two passport-sized photos with them for completion of their visa in the Phnom Penh airport.

If you will be lodging overnight in another country during your travel to or from Cambodia, you may be required to apply for a visa within that respective country. Build Cambodia staff will assist in this process once you have verified your travel plans.

Airport Departure/Exit Fee

Upon departure from Cambodia, all participants will be responsible for paying a \$25 Exit Fee at the Siem Reap airport.
